






BMW CCA Autocross Online Registration Procedure

- If you already have an account, click on 
- If you need to set up an account, click here 
- If you prefer to enter the website URL into your browser, use this address:
https://axwaresystems.com/axorm/calendar_main.php?viewevent=547&selectclubid=26&curmonthindex=3&curyearindex=3
- Create your own user ID, password, etc. (you only need to provide * items) and 
- Click on **Event Calendar** (left side, under **TASKS**). This will display the events you can sign up for (*which at this time is only one*).
- Chose the event you want and click on this icon:  (Register for an event)
- Click on **Create New Car** which is in the middle of the page. This will take you to the Garage Entry page.

You may enter as many cars as you want – later you can pick which car you use for an event.

- If you are unsure of what **Class** to put your car(s) in, please see the explanation at the bottom of this document.
- The **Number** you put in for each car must be unique. If someone else has already registered with that number, you will be directed to pick another. Do not use '-1'
- When you enter your **Emergency Contact** info, please include a phone number (i.e. Jane Doe, 213-555-1234)
- Be sure to **Save** the info for each car.
- After you have entered all the cars you want, go back to the **Event Calendar** page.
- Under the first tab, you'll see your cars listed. Check off the one you want to use for this event, then click on 
- Use the drop down menu to pick your entry fee. Add extra lunches and/or helmet rental if needed.
- Click on 
- To pay entry via credit card - click on 
- To pay via check - click on  * if Mail In Stub is missing the Mail To address, send envelope to Steve Potter, 495 Gatewood Lane, Sierra Madre, CA 91024

The next time you register for a Los Angeles Chapter Autocross (or any other event we use this system for) you will be able to log in and go straight to the Events page. You may add or subtract cars from your garage at any time.

X	Non-BMWs (stock ¹ or modified ²)

Stock (OEM or AFTERMARKET for the list below)

- Any size wheel (i.e. rim)
- Any size STREET tire (tread wear of 140 or above)
- Any size brake rotor (Euro-M3 floating rotors included)
- Any brake pad
- Any brand of shock absorber
- BMW cross-brace (i.e. X-brace) only
- Any air filter
- Any pre-throttle body intake
- Any exhaust system in back of the catalytic converter

² **Modified** (includes anything in Stock list above plus below)

- Any non-stock springs
- R-compound or racing slick tires
- Aftermarket lightweight or BIG brake kits
- Engine computer chip or computer system modifications
- And anything else NOT specified in the Stock list

FAQs

Q. *Are convertibles okay? What about non-street legal cars and non-BMW's?*

A. Yes, yes and yes. MINI's have their own run groups, all other non-BMW's go into the 'X' group.

Q. *Will instructors be available?*

A. Instructors are available to all during the practice sessions. Fewer instructors are available for timed sessions, but you can usually find one if you want one.

Q. *Can I take passengers?*

A. Only an instructor can ride with you. Time allowing, your friends may be able to get a ride with an instructor.

Q. *What is the basic schedule?*

A. There is a mandatory meeting for everyone at 8:00. Staff members do a vehicle safety check. Practice sessions take up the rest of the morning. Timed sessions start after lunch. Trophies are given at the end.

Q. *Do I need a helmet?*

A. Yes, bring one or rent one of ours.

Q. *Do I need to get my car pre-teched?*

A. No, there will be a safety check at the event. However, you should check the basics (oil, brake fluid and pads, tire pressures, etc.) before the event.

Q. *Will I get to work the course?*

A. Absolutely. Each group works the course while another group is running. If you don't work, you don't run.

Q. *Why do I have to sign a waiver at the beginning of the day?*

A. The chapter's liability insurance requires signatures from all participants, workers, spectators and anyone else who enters the rental lot. A sample of the standard waiver can be found on the chapter website (Club Haus. page).
